



## **Gilbert Ramirez, DrPH**

Dr. Ramirez is Professor at Charles R. Drew University of Medicine and Science, where he directs the Urban MPH Program in the College of Science and Health, Los Angeles, California. Gil's research interest and experience are in the area of evidence-based methodologies and meta-analysis. He served as the Co-Director of the San Antonio Cochrane Center and Associate Director of the San Antonio Evidence-based Practice Center (until the two centers closed in 2001). He was instrumental in helping establish a School of Public Health at the University of North Texas Health Science Center, Fort Worth, Texas. Prior to joining Charles R. Drew University of Medicine and Science, he served as the Dean of the College of Health Sciences, Des Moines University, Iowa. Gil served twenty years in the United States Army as an Environmental Science Officer. He obtained his BS in Environmental Health from East Tennessee State University, his MPH from the University of Hawaii, and his DrPH from the University of Texas – Houston.
